



Accessible Facility Policy

Caledon Soccer Club utilizes facilities that are owned by the Town of Caledon and School facilities geared to multiple access. Caledon Soccer Club does not own any facilities. The Town of Caledon facilities are in line with its Accessibility Compliance and 2018 – 2022 Multi-Year Accessibility Plan.

The Town is devoted to achieving full compliance with all standards under the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005* (AODA). Access to parks, playgrounds, facilities and all outdoor spaces is an integral part of the quality of life of the residents of Caledon. The Town is making it a priority to make changes to these areas to ensure that all residents have access and can participate equally.

- Partner with the Town of Caledon to ensure that future Parks & Recreation planning takes into consideration the following: accessible parking and curb ramps from parking onto sidewalks, Accessible Washrooms, Accessible pathways, Accessible doors, Accessible Lighting, Accessible signs, etc.
