Overview:

The Competitive Development Coach's position is responsible for providing leadership and the oversight of the development of one of the Grassroots Competitive teams. The position is to teach and develop young players within a safe, disciplined and challenging environment where they can learn to love the game and be encouraged to stay in the sport. The position manages all aspects of the competitive development team including games, practices, off-field activities. A Caledon Technical Team member will be scheduled to assist coaches with curriculum practices.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

Technical

- Ability to design, lead and implement training sessions based on the Age Group Curriculum, with assistance from Club Head Coach, and Technical mentor coach
- Oversee the scouting, identification and selection of players by scouting the Recreational Program a minimum 2x per season
- Attend all meetings with Club Head Coach and other Age Group Head Coaches.
- Conduct two training sessions per week and a game
- Travel with the team and attend all competitions/festivals and events.

Administration

- Prepare game sheets
- Parent meetings to ensure open team communications
- Report progress of the team to the Club Head Coach

Experience, Qualifications and Knowledge

- Minimum Ontario Soccer Learn to Train, will consider candidates without levels that are willing to complete them
- Ability to work evenings and weekends
- 1-5 years coaching experience at a competitive level with youth.
- Playing background in order to demonstrate technique
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
